



Instrumental Tutorial Program

We offer a variety of musical activities within the College. Students are also encouraged to participate in additional musical activities and lessons to complement their musical journey.

Specialist instrumental tutors operate in the College and offer tuition in a variety of instruments. These lessons attract a fee. Lessons are thirty minutes in duration and held each week. There is an expectation that children who participate in the Instrumental Tutorial Program will practise at home.

Lessons are available in the following:

- Piano/Keyboard
- Voice
- Guitar
- Bass Guitar
- Clarinet
- Saxophone
- Beginner brass (trombone, trumpet)
- Drums
- Violin

Fees

Each individual tutor will organise their tuition fee with the student and their family. As a guide \$35 is the minimum that a tutor will charge per half hour.

Students will be invoiced directly by the tutor each term.

Fee payments will not be accepted on behalf of tutors by the College administration staff.

Private Music Tuition Policy

By undertaking private music tuition at Oran Park Anglican College, all students and their parents agree to adhere to the following;

- All private tuition is arranged and paid for directly with the individual tutor. Oran Park Anglican College provides tuition rooms to tutors.
- Lesson times are arranged in consultation with the tutor, parent and classroom teacher. Junior School lesson times must be approved by the classroom teacher prior to commencement.
- Contact details of all tutors can be found on the school's website and are attached.

Missed Lessons

- Students who miss a lesson without 24hrs notice to the tutor will forfeit that lesson and no make-up lesson will be provided. The normal fee for that lesson is still payable.
- It is the student/parents responsibility to notify the tutor of **ANY** absence including excursions, camps, exams, sporting carnivals etc.
- Notification of the missed lesson must be through either text message or email.

Sickness

- Students who are absent from school due to sickness must contact the tutor by 8.30am on the day of absence or the lesson will be forfeited.
- Lessons missed due to sickness will only be 'made up' if notice has been given to the tutor.
- 'Make up' lesson times must be approved by the student's classroom teacher prior to commencement.
- Notification of the child's sickness must be through either text message or email.

Classwork

- It is the student's responsibility to catch up any classwork missed through attendance at a music lesson.
- Failure to catch up missed work may result in the discontinuation of private tuition at Oran Park Anglican College.

Payment

- Tutors rates may vary, but the standard rate is \$35 per half hour. This is paid directly to the individual tutor.
- Students may not recommence lessons if the previous terms lessons have not been paid.
